

Student Corner Video: AFO CPG Case Study






Don't miss this video case study for students, or any therapists wanting more experience with clinical decision making around AFO prescription!

Did you know that the APTA has a <u>Patient Action Center</u> where they can access resources to help with PT advocacy?

The damaging payment cuts and flawed PTA differential system being proposed in the 2022 Medicare Physician Fee Schedule are about **patient access.** If the rule is adopted as proposed, beneficiaries can anticipate reduced access to needed care, just as communities struggle with recovery from the effects of a pandemic.
